Silstab® 3000 is a general purpose non-hydrolyzable block copolymer of dimethylsiloxane and a polyoxyalkylene, to be used in the manufacture of TDI and TDI/MDI cold cure flexible polyurethane foams, including footwear applications.

Silstab® 3000 is a high efficiency surfactant with a broad processing latitude that produces high resiliency flexible moulded foams with reduced surface defects and low fogging. Applications include automotive seating and furniture.

In footwear applications, **Silstab® 3000** imparts improved flowability, eliminating surface defects.

The recommended concentration used is between 1.0 - 3.0% weight percent on the B-side.
