#### **DESCRIPTION**

**Silstab® 3165** is a general purpose non-hydrolyzable block copolymer of dimethylsiloxane and a polyoxyalkylene, to be used in the manufacture of conventional flexible slab stock foams. In addition, **Silstab 3165** is used in low density open cell rigid foam systems, including spray and packaging foams.

### **USES & APPLICATIONS**

**Silstab 3165** is a high efficiency surfactant with a broad processing latitude and is low fogging. **Silstab 3165** is methyl-capped, imparting superior long term hydrolytic stability of the B- or polyol side. Applications include furniture and carpet underlay.

The recommended concentration used is between 1.0 - 3.0% weight percent on the B-side.
