Suitable Extinguishing Media

May form explosive mixtures with air. Vapours are heavier than air and may travel considerable distances to a source of ignition and flashback.

**Other information** Recent results from a 2 year repeated vapour inhalation exposure study to rats of D4 indicate effects (benign uterine adenomas) in the uterus of female animals. These effects, which have been shown to be rat-specific, occur at the highest exposure does (700 ppm) only, a level that greatly exceeds typical workplace or consumer exposures. Industrial, commercial, or consumer uses of products containing D4 do not represent a risk to humans.
